



Michael Flaherty, who was born in St. Mary's, Puam on the February, 1948 called to enquire about his baptismal certificate. I would like to give you, in confidence, some details, so that it would not be embarrassing when he calls to you.

He was apparently admitted to the Regional Hospital after birth, and was baptised in the hospital on the February, 1948. The old baptismal certificate that we have shows his mother's name as Patricia Flaherty, and it is possibly to try to trace his mother that he is now looking for a baptismal certificate because he is not getting married until next year. He is illegitimate, and you might like to issue a certificate that does not show his mother's name as I have no record of her present whereabouts, nor do I know her circumstances. It is possible that she is married and has not told her husband that she had a child before marriage, so I think it is better that you should know this.

Father Dermody was enquiring about a baptismal certificate for Michael recently also, and he knows Michael was born in Tuem, but he may not know that he was baptised in the Regional Hospital.
