Over 15,000 people marched over a three mile route
down Southway into Lone Moore Rd down Stanley's Wk.
along Pecky Road back up Westland St and along
Raturnum Ice and Marlborough Ice and down Creggan St
into William St.

Civil Rights banners were carried by marchers
and the younger participants bore cards with the names
of the Jerry internees. The crowd ~~continued~~ continued
down William St while the Civil Right officials went
over Rossville St. There was an army Barricade across
by the Old City Cinema site some young boys threw

bottles + stones it wasn't serious in fact it was minor
to any roits I've seen An army Cannon moved up to the
barricade + sprayed purple dye. The crowd scattered
into Camberlain St (now known as S KID Alley)
the paratroopers supported by Saracens, moved into
Rossville St. on what the army called later as an arrest
and search operation. As the Saracens roared into the car
park everyone fled in various directions, the meeting
was about ^{to begin} against the drift of c.s. gas, and the threat of
rubber bullets. Then came the sound of live bullets
whining viciously on their death and injury-dealing way.
Everyone dived to the ground for safety. The first to
die was 17 year old Michael Kelly who was standing
less than 120 yds from the kneeling soldiers. Because of
the mingling sound of rubber bullets only those actually
helping knew he was shot.

William Nash 19, John Young, were ~~shot~~ shot dead
with Michael Kelly as they crossed the barricade
out-side the Rossville Flats.
In the Rossville car park Saracens pinned Alana
Burke 19, against a wall, seriously injuring her
Soldiers emerging from the carriers immediately shot
dead. Kevin McElhinney seeing McElhinney fall
Mickey Bridge ran out shouting "Murders!" he was
shot and wounded. also ~~shot~~ wounded Patric McPind

Michael Bradley
who in Glenfada Park tried to flee into Abbey Park
when soldiers who had come on foot from William St.
area, appeared at the narrow exit from Glenfada Park
to Abbey Park. James Wray 23, Gerald Donaghy, 17
Gerald Mc Kinney, 35 and William Mc Kinney, 27
were killed Joseph Friel and Patrick O'Donnell were
wounded.

The soldiers who had killed Michael Kelly, William Nash
and John Young stationed themselves at the low
wall in Rossville car park. Patrick Doherty, 21, and
Hugh Gilmour 17, who ran ~~as~~ into the line of fire
both dead. Bernard Mc Guigan 41, went to the
assistance of Doherty he too was shot dead. William Nash
ran to his son when he saw him fall he was shot and
wounded. So ended the 30th Jan Civil Rights march
already the army have their story told to the press and
said that only nail bombers, petrol bombers, and gun
men were shot dead yet every one shot was not
a member of the IRA.
