A SHOCKING report that found nuns working in mother and baby homes falsified infant deaths before selling the bables in the US was ignored by the Government, a former HSE chief has claimed.

Former HSE Children and Family Services assistant director Phil Garland says the explosive 2012 report was passed to then Minister for Children Frances Fitzgerald and Health Minister James Reilly — but despite recommendations for a State inquiry no action appears to have inquiry, no action appears to have been taken.

Breaking his silence for the first time on the reports he helped compile, Mr Garland told The Star: "The HSE and the Government weren't interested. And they still aren't."

#### Cash

The sensational "draft reports" surround both Bessborough institution in Co Cork and Sacred Heart Mother and Baby facility in Tuam, Co Galway and reveal claims that:

\* Irish parents were told their babies were dead before the tots were sold to desperate American couples for cash;

\* The Church was defrauding the Government, women and adoptive parents of cash:

\* Doctors, social workers and workers who helped 'traffic' children are still employed in HSE;

\* Bishops sent written requests for babies to be made available for adoption;

\* Over 1,000 records were unearthed by civil servants, including letters and photographs;





# Re: Request for Access to Records of Winifred Smyth, deceased Late of Breaffy, Ballina, Co Mayo

Dear Ms Larkin

I acknowledge receipt of copy of your baptism certificate and public services card as proof of identity in your request to access your late mothers, Winifred Smyth records held in the Sacred Heart Hospital, Castlebar, Co Mayo.

The following information highlighted in bold is also required in order to process your request:

The provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (Section 37(8)(b) and Statutory Regulation SI No.218/2016, deal with the administration of requests for the release of the personal records of deceased persons. The Regulations provide that notwithstanding Section 37(8)(b), a request in relation to personal records of a deceased individual may be granted where:-

- (a) the requester belongs to one of the following classes:
  - (i) a personal representative of the (deceased) individual acting in due course of administration of the individual's estate or any person acting with the consent of a personal representative so acting.
  - (ii) a person on whom a function is conferred by law in relation to the individual or his or her estate acting in the course of the performance of the function, or
- (b) the requester is the spouse or the next of kin of the individual and, in the opinion of the head, having regard to all the circumstances, the public interest, including the public interest in the confidentiality of personal information, would on balance be better served by granting than by refusing to grant the request.

The Regulation defines the next of kin as

(a) issue,

- (b) parent,
- (c) brother or sister
- (d) a niece or nephew, or
- (e) any other person standing nearest in blood relationship to the individual in accordance with section 71(2) of the Succession Act, 1965.

I would be grateful if you would clarify under which of the above classes you are applying for access to the late Ms Winifred Smyth's records.

If you are applying under class (a) (i) above, you should provide the **original or Probate office copy of the Grant of Probate** or Administration and evidence of identity to confirm that you are the person named in the Grant or written consent that you are acting on behalf of the personal representative.

If you are applying under class (a) (ii) above, you should provide the **official copy of the court order** where applicable, evidence of identity to confirm that you are the person appointed by the court order or authorised by the Statute.

If you are applying under class (b), spouse or next of kin, please provide an affidavit stating the relationship to the deceased up to the date of her death and exhibiting the necessary State Death Certificate. I would also be obliged if you would inform me of any public interest factors you wish me to consider that may be in favour of releasing the records to you.

I also request clarification as to the purpose for which the records are required so that I can determine if the request comes within the scope of the Regulations.

Once I receive this information, I will process your request.

Your correspondence will be processed under the Freedom of Information Act, 2014 as it relates to the records of a deceased person.

The provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (Section 37(8)(b) and Statutory Regulation SI No.218/2016, deal with the administration of requests for the release of the personal records of deceased persons. The Regulations provide that notwithstanding Section 37(8)(b), a request in relation to personal records of a deceased individual may be granted where:-

- (a) the requester belongs to one of the following classes:
  - (i) a personal representative of the (deceased) individual acting in due course of administration of the individual's estate or any person acting with the consent of a personal representative so acting,
  - (ii) a person on whom a function is conferred by law in relation to the individual or his or her estate acting in the course of the performance of the function, or
- (b) the requester is the spouse or the next of kin of the individual and, in the opinion of the head, having regard to all the circumstances, the public interest, including the public interest in the confidentiality of personal information, would on balance be better served by granting than by refusing to grant the request.
